# Passport Renewal in Chiang Mai

1. **Complete the Application online** – you need to create (or log into an existing) AusPassport account

Print (or save as a pdf and print) the completed Form

#### 2. Have a suitable photo taken

Guidelines are very strict – the Embassy will reject any that don't comply

There are 2 reliable photo shops in Chiang Mai – it is recommended to use one of these to save having the photo done again.

Make sure you ask for the photo printed on **gloss paper** and it is recommended you also get the photo file sent to you (email or Line)

## 3. Submit the Form

There are 2 options for submitting the completed printed form + photos + other documents. If you want the new passport sent EMS to your address, you need to enclose an addressed A5 envelope.
